Mission Statement

EF Elite Sale has a vision of offering well bred, European quality youngsters and going show horses to the North American market. Our goal is to present a small selection of horses with the athletic ability, natural talent and foundation to go on to sport at a high level in their chosen disciplines, whether that be as a Jr jumper, an amateur hunter or an FEI competitor. We are proud to offer a place to buy and sell top quality horses in an honest and transparent manner.

Sale Details

Dates: The sale will be a hybrid sale, with the sale opening on-line June 18th www.efelitesales.ca. Closing June 21st with a live event hosted by Rocky Mountain Show Jumping (RMSJ) in Calgary, AB. For in person viewing and tryouts, the horses will be located at RMSJ for the week of June 16th – 21st. Sale horses will be stabled together for the convenience of potential buyers to come and try their chosen prospects in one place. The riding horses may be competing at RMSJ for the week and are available for tryouts by appointment with the seller. All riding horses will be on the show grounds by June 16th. Weanlings will be there by no later than Friday night before the sale on Saturday for viewing.

Presentation Day and Videos: Riding horse presentation and videos done between May 5th-11th at RMSJ. Weanling videos are done at RMSJ, Elysian Farm or Valleyfield Farm depending on foals' location. Horses need to be turned out and braided to a professional level. If you are unable to, please contact the sale admin in plenty of time so that a braider and groom can be hired.

This is a select sale: horses will be accepted based on their show record, their potential for the show ring and their bloodlines. Horses may be asked to undergo a ridden assessment which will be preformed by an experienced test rider. EF Elite Sales will provide riders for the presentation days to showcase each horse to the best of their abilities.

Consignment fee: \$2,500 per horse. This covers the following costs: all advertising, photo and video shooting and editing, facility rental for presentation days and sale, stabling and office administrative fees. If a horse attends the presentation days but is unable to be offered for sale because of illness, soundness issues or an unsatisfactory PPE, then a refund of \$1,500 will be issued. The seller will be provided with all marketing material for their own personal use, with sale reference removed. If the horse is sold privately before sale date, there will be no refund.

Commission: 5% for the seller and 5% for the buyer. **Note:** Seller commission only applies to sales over \$50,000. The consignment fee is taken off the seller's commission when the horse is sold. If the horse is not sold there are no other fees owed.

Payment: EF Elite Sales only acts as a clearing house. They will collect payment from the buyer and distribute it to the consignor via the consignors preferred payment method. This will take between 3 and 10 business days, depending on the buyers' location and bank.

Entry qualifications: PPE due June 15, 2025

Horses must be registered/registration pending with a warmblood registry that is recognized by WBFSH. If horse a is 4 years or older, will be given to horses already registered. For foals and embryos, registration pending/paperwork completed is acceptable, proof of application must be included with entry.

All performance horses will be required to complete an extensive PPE within 30 days of the sale date. A complete set of x-rays that have been taken within 4 months of the sale will be required. Please have your own vet view and advise on them as horses will not be accepted into the sale with career limiting/ending issues. The x-rays will be viewed by qualified veterinarians to ensure that there are no career limiting/ending issues in their opinion. All prior injury/maintenance/vet work should be fully disclosed at time of entry to help the selection process. Horses will not be turned away with what is considered in the industry as normal or acceptable maintenance. See PPE requirements for additional information.

Foals will be required to complete a PPE, which will include an IGG, bloodwork and general well-being check over. See PPE requirements for additional information

Horses will be insured by BFL Canada for a period of 15 days after the sale closing date and will be boarded at no additional cost to the buyer for a period of 15 days after the sale close to ensure the buyer has adequate time to arrange transportation and their own insurance.

Implanted Embryo and Foal qualifications:

For implanted embryos, selection will be based on pedigree of both the sire and dam-line, preference given to implanted embryos with a unique, performance-based pedigree that is hard to obtain in North America. Embryo's must be a minimum of 60 days confirmed in the recipient at time of sale opening, last possible check June 16, 2025. Or when regular PPE is due, if that is past the 60 days. Mares who are due to foal in the current calendar year will be accepted on a case-by-case basis.

Foals will be accepted on a case-by-case basis. Their pedigrees need to be from hard to obtain bloodlines, not normally found in NA. Performance based mother-lines, dams or siblings who are performing at a high level/have produced offspring performing at a high level in their chosen discipline will be given priority. Sires who are hard to obtain, who are performing at a high level in their chosen discipline.

Performance horse qualification: Four and Five-year-old

Four and Five-year-old's must have attended shows, either schooling or recognized at an age-appropriate level. They must be jumping under saddle at a level that allows potential buyers to see their ability. They will not be asked to free jump during presentation days, only to jump under saddle. If being presented as an amateur friendly prospect, they must in the opinion of the selection committee show the temperament and ride-ability of an amateur friendly horse. If being presented as an upper-level prospect they must show clear ability for the upper levels.

Performance horse qualification: Six-year-old and up

Performance horses who are six years and older must be actively competing at recognized competitions, showing clear development towards their careers in the Jumper, Equitation or Hunter rings at an age-appropriate level. If being presented as an amateur friendly mount, they must in the opinion of the selection committee show the temperament and ride-ability of an amateur friendly horse. If being presented as an upper-level prospect/made horse, they must show clear ability for the upper levels or already be at the upper levels if they are of an appropriate age. School masters are welcome and will be accepted on a case-by-case basis.
